For three nights in January, Kate Werble Gallery presents *OUT OF BODY OW! TUF BODY*, a very physical performance of songs and stories by musician/performer Geo Wyeth.

Inspired by Situationist performances from the 1950s and 60s, and his recent experiences working at the Apple Store, Wyeth uses the gallery space to evoke a physicality of alienation and ecstasy. The songs are real and imagined moments of queer rapture, corporate landslide, ancestral vengeance, and alien love. *OUT OF BODY OW! TUF BODY* coincides with Wyeth's first full length album release *ALIEN TAPES*, a pop-up book and 12-inch LP featuring artwork by Tuesday Smillie. The album will be available in Spring 2012.

Geo Wyeth (fka Novice Theory) is a New York City based musician who uses his body to channel stories as a means of interruption. His solo music performance has been featured at PS1 MOMA (NY ArtBook Fair 2011), Socrates Sculpture Park, The New Museum, SFMOMA, and Joe's Pub. Wyeth's songs and stories are darkly humorous and ecstatic meditations on the absurdity of embodied experience, and draw inspiration from both experimental and popular musical forms. He is an out female to male transsexual and was born in New York City in 1984.
