Brock Enright (closes on Saturday) This artist, who made his name with ambiguous, slightly scary videos that may have recorded actual kidnappings, tries his hand at what might be called disturbing elegance, by scratching tangles of spidery lines into mirrors and lighting them from behind. The series title — "Autumn" — evokes Pollock's "Autumn Rhythm." The linear delicacies of Wols and the slices (and slickness) of Lucio Fontana are precedents.
